Dear Parents/Guardians,

In order for your child to achieve success in school this year, we need to develop teamwork between student, home, and school.

All students are expected to follow Greenfield School Board Policies as described in the Student Agenda, which your child has already received. In addition to following this "code of conduct", students are expected to accept any and all consequences, both positive and negative, that they have earned through their behaviors. Violet House Teachers require communication between home and school on a daily basis. Students will be assigned homework in various subjects daily and are responsible for recording their daily class activities and/or homework in all subjects on the correct day in their agendas. We then ask that you review this part of the agenda with your child every day. **We expect that a parent or guardian's signature will be on the bottom portion of the agenda each day.** The bottom portion is also an excellent place for parents to write notes or comments to teachers or your child. Students who are consistently filling out their agenda and having a parent or guardian sign will be rewarded.
